Ephesians 6 1 Children, obey your parents because you belong to the Lord, for this is the right thing to do. 2 “Honor your father and mother.” This is the first commandment with a promise: 3 If you honor your father and mother, “things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth.”

A few Examples of Parental rights in Arizona

- Direct the education of their child.
- Direct the upbringing of their child.
- Direct the moral or religious training of their child.
- Make healthcare decisions for their child.
- Opt out of any learning material or activity that the parent finds harmful to the student. This includes material that questions beliefs or practices related to sex, morality, or religion.
- Notification in advance if content discussing sexuality is taught in other classes, such as history or literature, and the right to opt your child out of that instruction.

- Opt in to any video, audio, or electronic materials that are inappropriate for the age of the student. This means the school cannot show a rated-R movie to students under 18 years old without signed, written permission from the child's parent.
- Opt out of instruction on the acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS).
- Excuse the student from school attendance for religious purposes.
- Public review of courses of study and textbooks.

If you honor your father and mother, "things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth."

Deuteronomy 6 5 And you must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength. 6 And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. 7 Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. 8 Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. 9 Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Action Steps

- Are you a Believer? A follower of Christ? (Saved/made new)
 - **Deuteronomy 6** 2 ... *you and your children and grandchildren must fear the LORD your God as long as you live. If you obey all his decrees and commands, you will enjoy a long life.*
 - Repentance starts with us asking God — Forgiveness we receive from God for OUR sins/failures to obey, etc. - then forgiveness moves to parents/children = New Beginning!
- 2 Corinthians 5** 17 *This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!*
