Accountability Questions

- Are you giving as God has asked you to give? (T, T, R)

Exodus 13 17 When Pharaoh finally let the people go, God did not lead them along the main road that runs through Philistine territory, even though that was the shortest route to the Promised Land. God said, “If the people are faced with a battle, they might change their minds and return to Egypt.”

18 So *God led them in a roundabout way* through the wilderness toward the Red Sea. Thus the Israelites left Egypt like an army ready for battle.

Exodus 13 19 Moses took the bones of Joseph with him, for Joseph had made the sons of Israel swear to do this. He said, “God will certainly come to help you. When he does, you must take my bones with you from this place.” 20 The Israelites left Succoth and camped at Etham on the edge of the wilderness. 21 The LORD went ahead of them. He guided them during the day with a pillar of cloud, and he provided light at night with a pillar of fire. This allowed them to travel by day or by night. 22 And the LORD did not remove the pillar of cloud or pillar of fire from its place in front of the people.

Exodus 3 1 Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. (*Also called Mt. Sinai*)

11 But Moses protested to God, “Who am I to appear before Pharaoh? Who am I to lead the people of Israel out of Egypt?” 12 God answered, “I will be with you. And this is your sign that I am the one who has sent you: *When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God at this very mountain.*”

Action Steps

- Have you accepted Jesus Christ as your Savior?
- Are you following the Holy Spirit's lead in your life?
- Are you wrestling with God on the direction of your life?
- Are you simply inviting God on your journey? Asking Him to bless your plans or are you surrendered – trusting – and obeying His lead in your life?
