Accountability Questions

- Are you giving as God has asked you to give? (T, T, R)

Ezekiel 12 21 Again a message came to me from the Lord:
22 “Son of man, you’ve heard that proverb they quote in
Israel: ‘*Time passes, and prophecies come to nothing.*’ 23 Tell
the people, ‘This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I will put
an end to this proverb, and you will soon stop quoting it.’
Now give them this new proverb to replace the old one: ‘*The
time has come for every prophecy to be fulfilled!*’ 24 “There
will be no more false visions and flattering predictions in
Israel. 25 For I am the LORD! If I say it, it will happen. There
will be no more delays, you rebels of Israel. I will fulfill my
threat of destruction in your own lifetime. I, the Sovereign
LORD, have spoken!” 26 Then this message came to me from

the LORD: 27 “Son of man, the people of Israel are saying, ‘He’s talking about the distant future. His visions won’t come true for a long, long time.’ 28 Therefore, tell them, ‘This is what the Sovereign Lord says: No more delay! I will now do everything I have threatened. I, the Sovereign LORD, have spoken!’”

2 Peter 3 2 I want you to remember what the holy prophets said long ago and what our Lord and Savior commanded through your apostles. 3 Most importantly, I want to remind you that in the last days scoffers will come, mocking the truth and following their own desires. 4 They will say, “What happened to the promise that Jesus is coming again? From before the times of our ancestors, everything has remained the same since the world was first created.” 5 They deliberately forget that God made the heavens long ago by the word of his command, and he brought the earth out from the water and surrounded it with water. 6 Then he used the water to destroy the ancient world with a mighty flood. 7 And

by the same word, the present heavens and earth have been stored up for fire. They are being kept for the day of judgment, when ungodly people will be destroyed. 8 But you must not forget this one thing, dear friends: A day is like a thousand years to the Lord, and a thousand years is like a day. 9 The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise, as some people think. No, he is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to be destroyed, but wants everyone to repent. 10 But the day of the Lord will come as unexpectedly as a thief. Then the heavens will pass away with a terrible noise, and the very elements themselves will disappear in fire, and the earth and everything on it will be found to

deserve judgment. 11 Since everything around us is going to be destroyed like this, what holy and godly lives you should live, 12 looking forward to the day of God and hurrying it along. On that day, he will set the heavens on fire, and the elements will melt away in the flames. 13 But we are looking forward to the new heavens and new earth he has promised, a world filled with God's righteousness. 14 And so, dear friends, while you are waiting for these things to happen, make every effort to be found living peaceful lives that are pure and blameless in his sight. 15 And remember, our Lord's patience gives people time to be saved.

Revelation 22 12 “Look, I am coming soon, bringing my reward with me to repay all people according to their deeds. 13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.”
